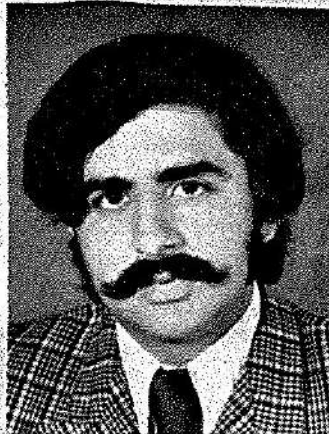
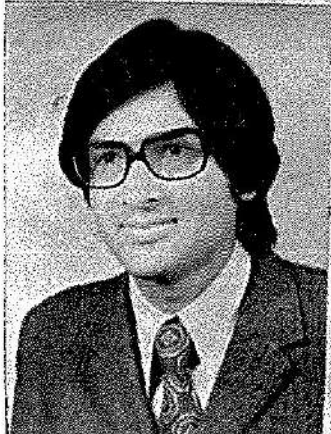
BALRAJ GUPTA

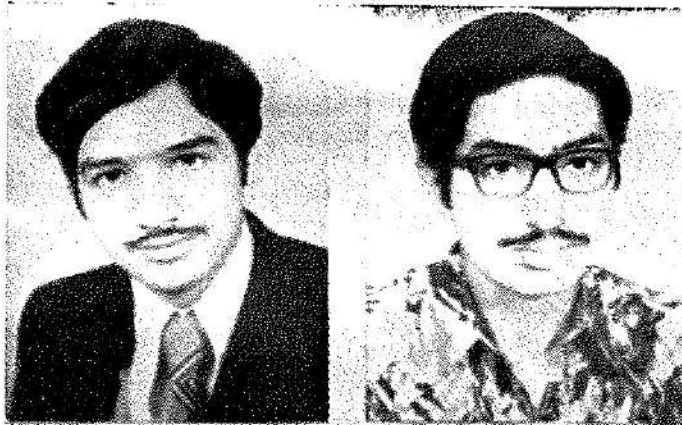

clubs of the college.

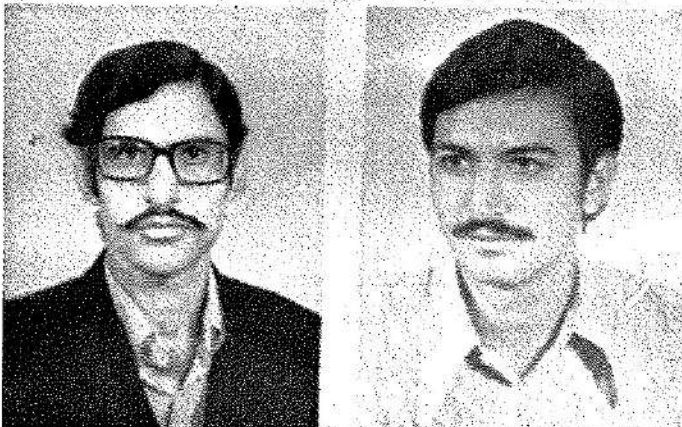

photography and swimming.

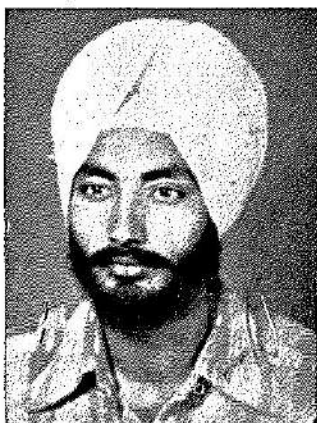


SURINDER SAROHIA

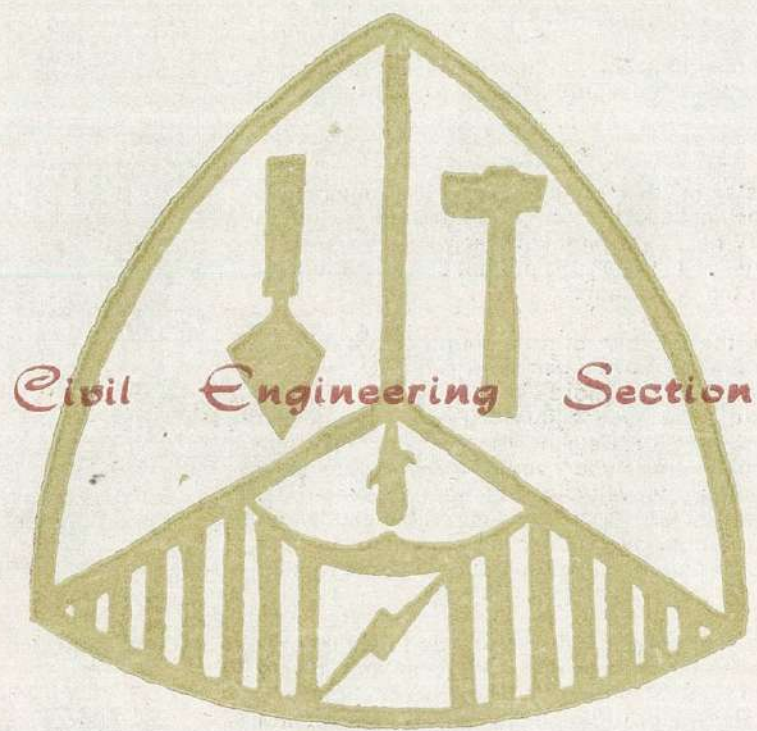


UMESH KUMAR AGGARWAL

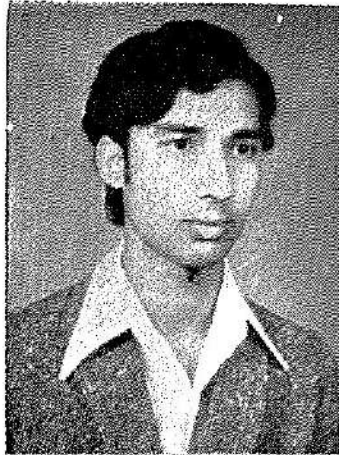

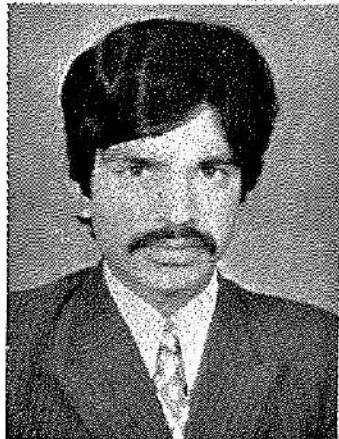
Popularly known as 'Kabira'—

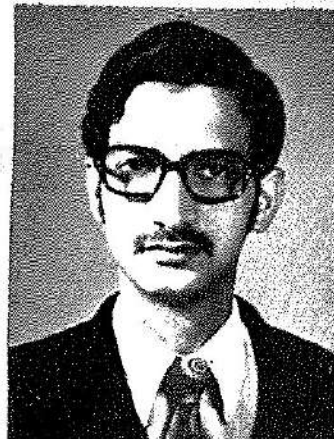
Smart and diligent, Avtar knows

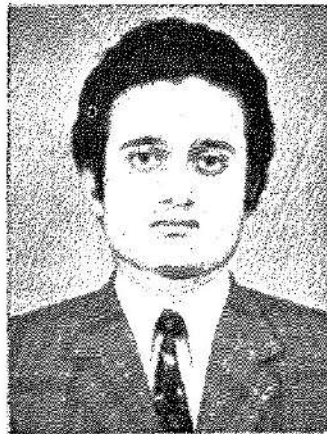

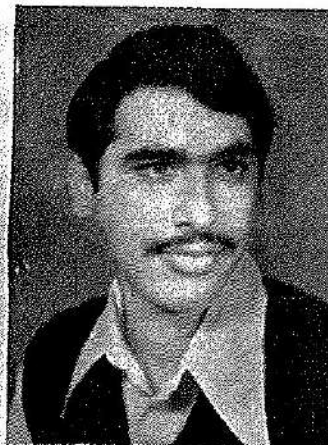

SURINDERJIT SINGH

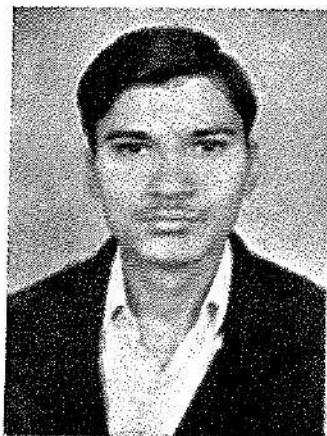

S/o Sh. Chander Lal 42, The Mall Simla-1

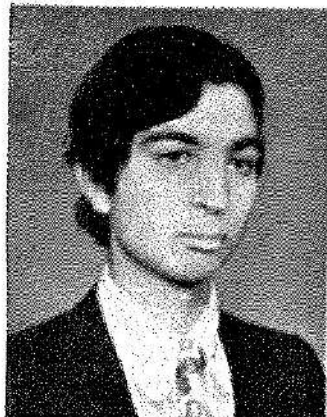

**GURINDER CHADHA**

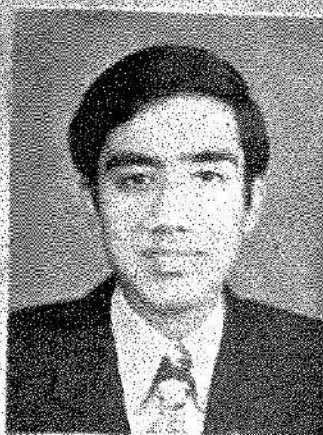
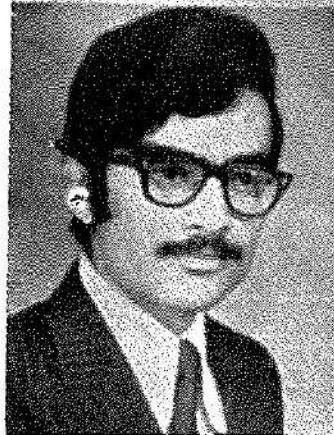

Model Town Ludhiana.

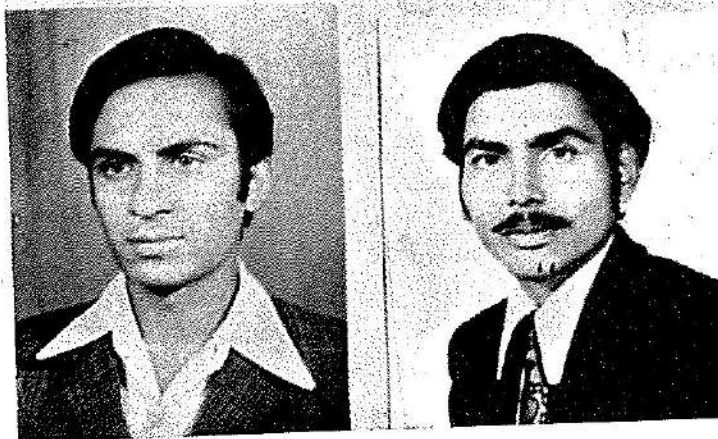

SHIV RAINA

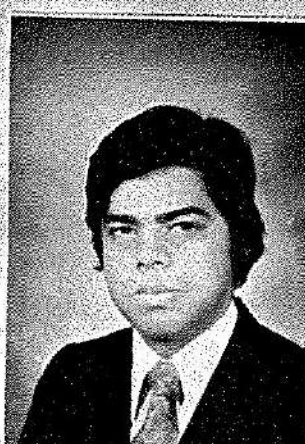
