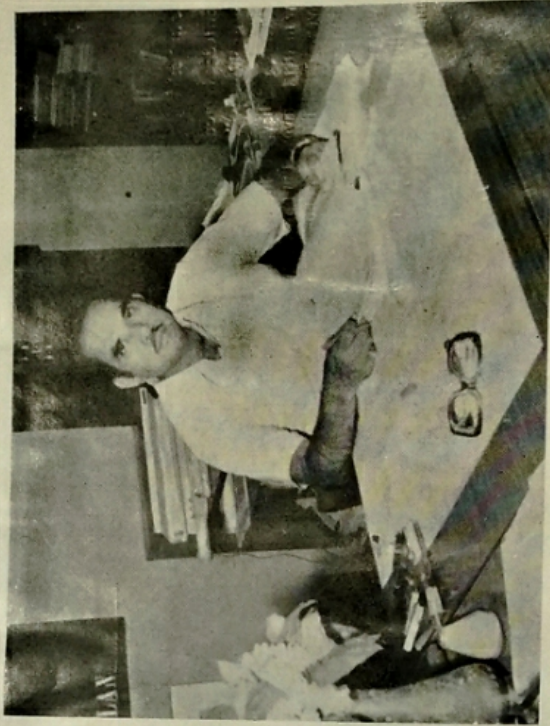
### *Message*
